

Unicollege is a degree-granting Italian university, accredited by the **Italian Ministry of University and Research (MUR)**, that hosts U.S. students for semester, year, faculty-led and short-term programs. Below is what your students and your office most need to know, in the order an education-abroad advisor evaluates a partner.

01 HEALTH, SAFETY AND STUDENT SUPPORT

A dedicated **Study Abroad Office** supports each student and the home institution **from application through completion**. All international students live in university-managed or formally affiliated housing, so accommodation is a built-in layer of supervision rather than a loose arrangement. Italy is consistently regarded as one of Europe's safe and welcoming destinations for visiting students.

02 ACADEMIC QUALITY AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Each course awards **3 U.S. semester credits (6 ECTS)**, structured over 45 academic hours in full alignment with U.S. standards; students carry **12 to 15 credits per semester**. Unicollege issues its own official academic transcript, designed to be directly recognizable for U.S. credit transfer. When a home institution requires a domestic U.S. transcript, **Westcliff University, a WASC-accredited U.S. institution, serves as School of Record**.

03 TRACK RECORD AND OUTCOMES

- 90+ partner universities across 40+ countries, including 40+ partners in the United States and Canada.
- 94% graduate employment or postgraduate placement rate.
- 500+ international partners for internships and professional placements; four double-degree programs.
- Active in Erasmus+; presented at the 2026 NAFSA conference.

04 HOUSING ARRANGED BY THE UNIVERSITY

Placement is handled within Unicollege's own residences and affiliated housing network in Florence, Mantua and Turin. **Published costs include accommodation and a semester meal plan**; the final address and check-in details are confirmed before the start of the term, so students arrive to a known, vetted place to stay.

05 TRANSPARENT, ALL-IN COST

Free-mover (fee-paying) tuition is **EUR 300 per credit**, and published program costs already fold in housing and the meal plan. Optional credit-bearing field trips to Siena, Pisa, Bologna and Rome are EUR 200 each, transport and instruction included. No opaque add-ons after enrollment.
